OPCC Webinar: How to report to the One Planet City Challenge - scope, plan, submit

Cities wishing to participate in the One Planet City Challenge (OPCC) are invited to report their climate ambitions through CDP's reporting platform. This tutorial webinar will guide participants on how to use the reporting platform and successfully submit data to the OPCC. The OPCC assesses the gap between a city's current emissions and the safe range (limiting global warming to 1.5). We also advice on high impact reduction actions.

OPCC Webinar: Science-based targets for cities, evidence based climate action planning, the One Planet City Challenge, and the Paris Agreement.

We guide participants on how to achieve science-based targets and evidence-based climate action planning based on different tools designed for the One Planet City Challenge (OPCC).

To help concentrate ambition and catalyze action, the OPCC supports joining cities to show that they have science-based emissions reduction targets that align with a 1.5 °C future and are supported by evidence-based climate action planning.

In 2015, the Paris Agreement was signed, a historic accord which brought together nearly 200 nations in a joint commitment to reduce GHG emissions. The aim was to limit global temperature increase to well-below 2.0 °C and endeavor to limit warming to 1.5 °C rise.

Getting the most from your climate disclosure with WWF's One Planet City Challenge and CDP

Are you curious how your city's goals and action stack up to the latest climate science? This year, as part of your CDP disclosure, you can enter World Wildlife Fund's One Planet City Challenge (OPCC) and receive actionable feedback about how your city measures up to a 1.5 degree reduction pathway. You can also see you work side-by-side with a diverse global cohort of cities for insight exploring new ideas.

Now in its eighth year, the OPCC is an initiative organized by WWF to guide cities towards the most effective, evidence-based climate action, as well as recognize outstanding leadership.

WWF, together with C40 and Arup have developed a new assessment methodology expanding on C40's Deadline 2020 framework allowing any city to better measure their action in-line with the Paris Agreement and IPCC 1.5 report. Cities wishing to participate in the One Planet City Challenge (OPCC) are invited to report their climate ambitions through CDP's reporting platform.
