Transitioning to Zero Carbon and Climate Resilient Buildings through Financial and Certification Tools

In 2019, approximately 30% of climate change mitigation actions reported by cities through CDP were targeting the buildings sector while a range of adaptation actions are also being taken to increase the resilience of buildings and hazard resistant infrastructure design and construction. CDP together with IFC (International Finance Corporation) will co-present key insights on the transition to green and resilient buildings in cities, and how the EDGE certification and tool, and Building Resilience Index can enable local governments and the real estate sector to increase transparency and accountability, decrease risk through clear and quantifiable assessments, and untap potential investments.

Climate Risk and Vulnerability Assessments in Cities

85% of cities reported climate hazards in 2019 but only 46% of these cities completed risk and vulnerability assessments that help them assess the real-world impact of these hazards. Comprehensive risk and vulnerability assessments are critical to develop a picture of current and future climate risks and opportunities. This webinar will provide information on how to assess adaptive capacity and cope with uncertainty with a particular spotlight on water security within risk and vulnerability assessments. The City of Cascais, Portugal will share their experiences producing a risk and vulnerability assessment and we will hear from the CDP Director of Water Security on the methods of integrating water into effective climate risk and vulnerability assessments.
